About Bridges IICAPS Program

Bridges IICAPS program provides therapeutic services to children, youth and families in their homes and in their communities. Services are provided by a clinical team which includes a Master's level clinician and a Bachelor's level mental health counselor. The clinical team is supported by a clinical supervisor and a child and adolescent psychiatrist. Service duration is six months and the program accepts only Husky insurance.

Services Provided by IICAPS

- Individual and family therapy at least twice a week
- 24-hour-a-day/7-day-a-week crisis response
- Parental guidance and education
- School consultation
- Comprehensive treatment planning
- Case Management services
- Psychiatric consultation



Who We Serve

IICAPS offers intensive clinical services and support to children and youth returning from out-of-home care or to children and youth at risk of requiring out-of-home care due to psychiatric, emotional, or behavioral difficulties. Anyone can make referrals to IICAPS. Common referral sources include hospitals, schools, community providers, and DCF.

Where We Serve

Bridges IICAPS provides services to children and their families in the towns of Milford, Orange, West Haven, Shelton, Seymour, Derby, Ansonia, Bethany and Woodbridge.
